SOME THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE PHOTO ORGANIZING PROCESS

Our first meeting will be in your home, if possible. All I ask you to do before we first meet is to gather your photos in one location and be able to tell me on what devices and platform you have your photos.

We will spend a few minutes discussing your goals for the organizing project. I will keep those goals in mind as I develop a plan of action for your project. Be ready to provide me with names and birthdays of family members as well as dates of other important milestones such as anniversaries.

I will take your prints or a copy of your digital photos offsite to organize only with your approval. Otherwise, we will schedule regular times when I can come to your house to work on the project. I will check in with you from time to time with questions and updates on my progress. When the project is complete, we will schedule a time for delivery.

I understand that your photo collection is deeply meaningful to you. I will treat your photographs as if they

were my own. I consider it an honor to be trusted with your treasured photo collection. I look forward to working with you!
